

Covid-19 Surfers Paradise Bridge Club Entry Protocol for Queensland Stage 3 Easing of Restrictions

Procedures Required for Entry to the Bridge Play at Surfers Paradise Bridge Club Until Further Notice

1. **Covid-Safe app:** Queensland Health guidelines recommend the Covid-Safe app is downloaded to your smartphone and the Club encourages all members to comply.
2. **Initial Entry:** Registered members only should arrive at the club no later than 15 minutes before the scheduled start time. Proceed through the Main Entrance (on Carrara St) and use the hand sanitiser (which will be both alcohol and non – alcohol based) stationed at the entry point.
If there is a group at the entry, please wait outside in the covered area.
Members must bring their own pencil/ball-point pen, drinks and snacks for their own exclusive use.
There will be **NO** Hot or Cold Water available (for at least the first week).
No refrigerators will be operating.
3. **Number of Players Allowed:** Under the current Stage 3 Easing Restrictions, from 10th July, 116 persons will be allowed indoors per 4 square metre rule.
4. **Personal Health Declaration:** Complete and sign personal Health Declaration. If you answer NO to all the questions, you may enter the Club premises (subject to a temperature check - see item 5).
If you answer YES to any question, you will be required to leave the premises.
All forms will be retained by the Club as required by Government regulations.
5. **Personal Temperature:** Your temperature will be taken and recorded on your Questionnaire. If your temperature is elevated – at 37.5 degrees - entry is not permitted. You will need to seek medical attention from your GP or the Hospital.
6. **Payment of Entry Fees:** If entry is approved – Table Fee is by ticket only.
All payments for tickets is to be by **EFTPOS** (tap & go) only. **NO CASH** accepted.
7. **Initial Hand Wash:** Once this is completed, please go to the nearest hand washing facility, and thoroughly wash your hands with soap and water as per the Covid-19 protocol.
Dry your hands with paper towel.
Collect Bidding Box and cleaning cloth from storage box and take to your table. These items remain with you during the day.
8. **Take your seat:** Sit at one of the enlarged social distance compliant tables in preparation for the Bridge session.
Ensure you have your pen with you.
Please sanitise your hands with the provided dispenser when you first sit down.
9. **Bridgemate Use:** The designated user of the Bridgemate (North / South) will sanitise it with a Wipe and will be the only person to handle it over the course of the session.
North / South will display the result appropriately at the conclusion of each hand so that the opposition can check all scoring.
10. **Bidding:** This will be by using the bidding boxes provided. Extra bidding boxes are being purchased to enable rotation of bidding boxes over a 3 day period.
11. **During Play:** Players must not touch any items not directly associated with play.
They must only touch the 13 cards associated with their hand.
All personal equipment must be stored on a player's personal side table.

12. **End of Round:** At the end of each round, players must sanitise their own hands and their individual table before moving to the next round.
All card holders must be sanitised with a wipe before passing on.
North / South must sanitise the Bridgemates at the end of each round.
13. **Directors Station:** will remain in present position – **only 1** (one) person permitted in that area at any one time.
14. **The Club Office:** Entry to the office will be restricted 2 persons at any one time – with 1 (one) being the person designated to selling tickets – **EFTPOS** only.
Any item that is handled or touched in the Office **MUST** be sanitised by the person who handled or touched that item.
15. **Club Kitchen:** Use of the kitchen facilities is **NOT PERMITTED**.
All crockery, cups, plates, glasses belonging to the Club are out of bounds and must not be accessed.
Please bring your own drink / food if required and come prepared to take dirty items home with you.
16. **Air-Conditioning:** Air-conditioners will **NOT** be used.
All members should bring appropriate clothing to cover any situation.
17. **Coffee/Tea Break:** There will be a 10 minute break in play at Director's discretion.
Additional time will be added to each round.
No food will be provided by the Club.
NO Hot or Cold Water will be provided. The coffee machine will not be working.
Please bring any snacks you may require.
18. **Close of Play:**
Bidding boxes should be sanitised and then returned to storage box.
Cleaning cloths to be placed in washing basket.
Each member should remove all personal belongings – including any rubbish.
Please remember social distancing when checking results on the result sheet.
19. **Before you Leave:** Please double check that anything at all that you have handled during the session has been sanitised prior to leaving the premises.
Sanitising equipment will be available at every point in the Club which will be accessed by members - **Please use**.
20. **Last person in the Club:** Will do a final check.
